



Vinyl Coated Fabrics General Care and Cleaning Guide

Marine vinyl, like all upholstery, requires a regularly scheduled cleaning program on a daily, weekly or monthly basis, depending upon the use and exposure to dirt and/or other staining agents. It is important that efforts begin immediately after a spill to remove any potential staining agent.

- Step #1:** Most common everyday light soiling can be easily removed by using a solution of 10% liquid household dish soap and 90% warm water, applied with a clean dampened cloth. Rinse with a clean cloth dampened with water and allow to dry. Moderate scrubbing with a soft bristle brush will help loosen dirt and grime embedded in the grain of the vinyl.
- Step #2:** For more stubborn stains and heavy soiled areas, dampen a soft white cloth with our V-Clean[®] or a mild detergent. Rub gently and rinse with a clean cloth and water. Please note, do not use any “citrus formula” detergents.
- Step #3:** For the most difficult stains and surface mildew, dampen a clean white cloth with a solution of 10% household bleach and 90% water. Rub gently and rinse with a clean cloth and water.
